



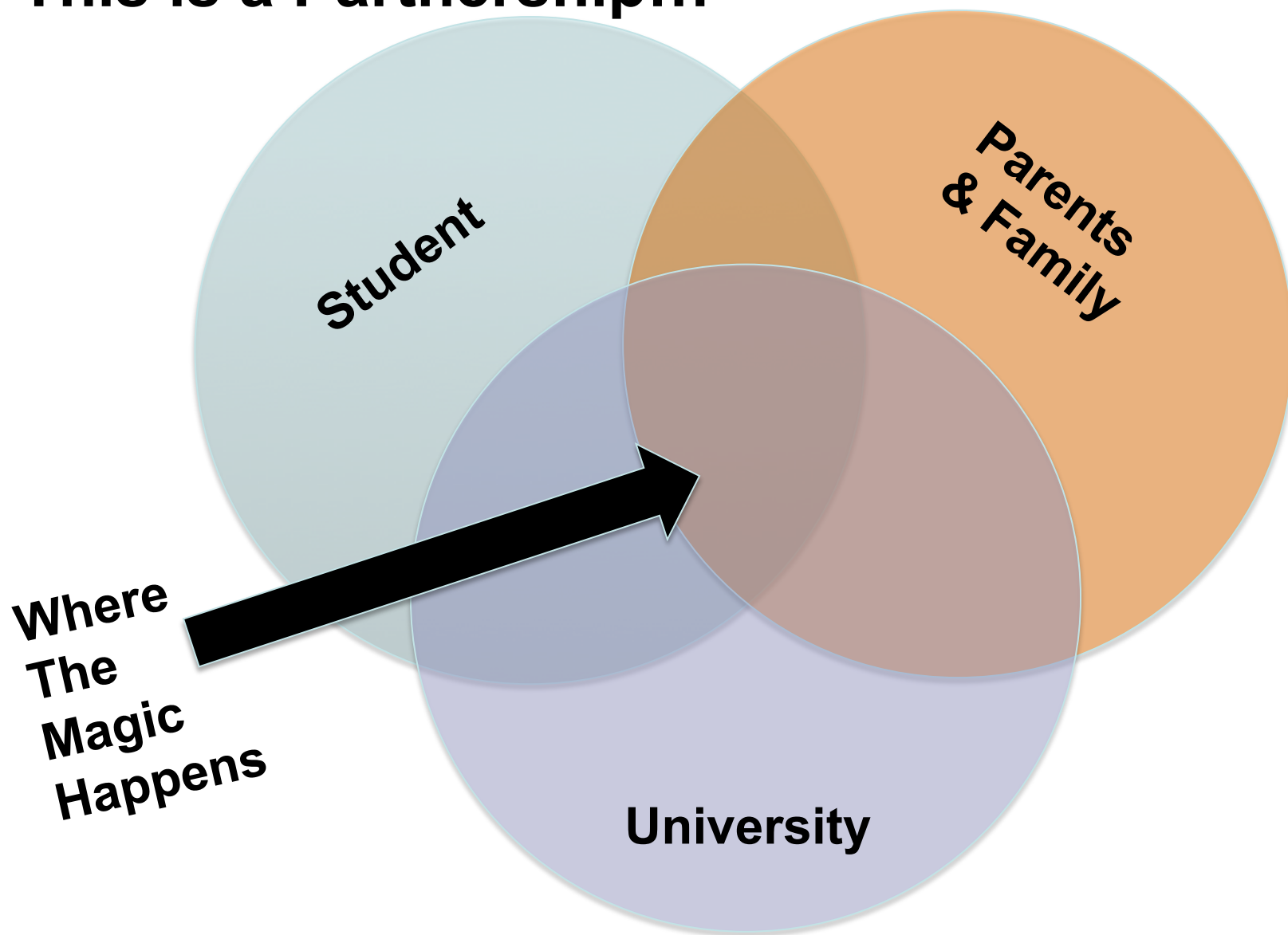

## New Student Orientation – Summer 2016

### First-Year Students:

Two Day Program with One Overnight in University Residence Hall. *14 Program Dates June-August*

### Transfer & Non-Traditional Students:

One Day Program with Optional Extended Evening/Overnight on One Program Date. *5 Program Dates June-August*

All New Students are **expected to attend** an Orientation program and are **responsible for all material covered** during the programs. There is **no additional cost** for New Student Orientation.

## Rutgers Check-List...

- Student should **accept admission** & pay enrollment deposit fee by **May 1, 2016**.
- Student should **activate SCARLEMAIL** email account and monitor it regularly.
- Students wishing to live on-campus should apply for housing on the Enrollment Pathway **ASAP**.
- Students should complete **on-line placement tests** and attend **academic advising** session (if required)
- Select an **Orientation** session by **June 1, 2016**.
- Parents/Family members **purchase tickets** for an Orientation session by June 1, 2016 (*Space is limited*)
- Student should complete **required online modules** (sent to Scarletmail) prior to the start of classes.
- Students and parents should develop a **communication plan** & set expectations for the Rutgers experience.
