

Two Day Program with One Overnight in University Residence Hall. 14 Program Dates June-August

### **Transfer & Non-Traditional Students:**

One Day Program with Optional Extended Evening/Overnight on One Program Date. 5 Program Dates

June-August

All New Students are <u>expected to</u> <u>attend</u> an Orientation program and are <u>responsible for all material</u> <u>covered</u> during the programs. There is <u>no additional cost</u> for New Student Orientation.

Students need to complete four required online modules prior to the start of classes.







#### **Rutgers Check-List...**

- Student should accept admission & pay enrollment deposit fee by May 1, 2016.
- Student should activate SCARLETMAIL email account and monitor it regularly.
- Students wishing to live on-campus should apply for housing on the Enrollment Pathway ASAP.
- Students should complete on-line placement tests and attend academic advising session (if required)
- Select an Orientation session by June 1, 2016.
- Parents/Family members purchase tickets for an Orientation session by June 1, 2016 (Space is limited)
- Student should complete required online modules (sent to Scarletmail) prior to the start of classes.
- Students and parents should develop a communication plan & set expectations for the Rutgers experience.
